In Term 1, we have arranged for two exceptional guest choreographers to collaborate with our Open and Prepro teams, bringing their expertise and creativity to our dance community. These choreographers are set to create fierce, unique, and competitive routines that will undoubtedly challenge and inspire all of our dancers.

First up is Lewis Shilvock, an extraordinary choreographer we've exclusively brought to WA from the eastern states for a limited time. Lewis will be working closely with our Pre-Pro Team to craft a one-of-a-kind jazz piece. Due to the short duration of his visit, we've adjusted our timetable to accommodate a 6-hour rehearsal session with Lewis this week on Wednesday 14th and Thursday 15th February. Please note the following changes:

During Week 3 of Term 1:

- Open Teams: There will be no classes on the evenings of the 14th and 15th of February.
- **Pre-Pro Teams:** Instead, the Pre-Pro teams will have extended dance classes from **5:45 pm to 8:45 pm** on both days to work exclusively with Lewis. Attendance on these days for all pre-pro students is **compulsory.**

For Open Teams:

Don't worry! Missed classes for the Open team will be rescheduled for later dates. We plan to hold makeup classes during week 11 of Term 2, where Open will have classes on both Wednesday and Thursday in their usual time slots, as well as during Pre-Pro's time slots. Pre-Pro teams will NOT have any classes during week 11. This ensures that all students receive the full benefit of their dance training while also providing some relief for our senior students during their busy Year 11 & 12 schedules.

Our second incredible guest choreographer is Kenisha Yam, renowned for her expertise in lyrical dance. Kenisha will be crafting a lyrical piece for both our Open and Pre-Pro teams, adding her unique touch to our performances.
